WHAT DOES IT MEAN TO BE A RED SHIRTED PLAYER

A Red Shirted player in development/select soccer means that the player registers in the SYSA club/house program and must commit to ALL of their team's practices & games. As long as they're fulfilling those obligations to their club/house team they're encouraged to attend the non-conflicting practices with the development/ select team.

A Red Shirted player can only be used when a registered development/select player is unable to play due to illness, injury or personal reasons beyond the player's control.

In the event of possible movement between a Red Shirt and rostered player a decision will be made in regards to the roster with consultation from the technical committee and the team coaches.
