



## SYSA 2020 DEVELOPMENT & SELECT PROGRAM

As many of us expected, as of June 10th the Thompson-Okanagan Youth Soccer League (TOYSL) has canceled its season. This means there will be no Development or Select Spring 2020 league or Provincial Playdowns.

### FINANCIAL SITUATION

SYSA is in a unique situation, where by having all of our spring programming canceled we have lost nearly 100% of our annual revenue. Not only are we currently operating in a large deficit, but the spring program is what enables us to provide year round programming like camps, tournaments, evaluations, and indoor programs. We know many of you may also be experiencing financial difficulty, so we have received a \$40,000 loan from the government of Canada to be able to fully refund anyone who needs it. We would like to kindly ask anyone who is able to contribute to the club to consider reimbursement options 1 or 2 below.

#### Reimbursement Details:

As we were in the middle of our second wave of registration for Development/Select when the COVID-19 suspension was implemented, the reimbursement process will be broken down below.

**Fall Commitment Fee:** \$100 paid in Fall 2019.

The fall commitment fee will be absorbed by SYSA to cover the Fall/Winter team practice costs, teamsnap subscriptions, BC Soccer player insurance, as well as TOYSL and SYSA administrative costs.

**Fundraising Fee:** \$60.

Those who have paid their entire 2020 registration fee had their fundraising fee refunded before May 31st.

**Remainder of Development/Select Fees:** Development \$120, Select \$140.

Those who have paid their entire 2020 registration fee can choose from one of the following options below.

### YOUR CLUB – YOUR CHOICE

#### Reimbursement options:

1. Carry over your registration for a dollar amount credit to Spring 2021 (House or Development/Select)
2. Receive a Refund, less a contribution of your choice in support of the club. (example: 10% or \$10)
3. Receive a full refund.
