

# SYSA Annual General Meeting 2022 - Operations Report

## Year In Review:

In Fall 2021 we began our 2022 programming with no on-field restrictions for participants, only requiring proof of vaccination for adults (coaches and spectators). Though this likely had a small impact on who was comfortable with enrolling their children in our indoor programs, our on-field product was once again "normal".

Spring 2022 SYSA was able to deliver our first full (unrestricted) Spring Outdoor program since 2019 with 1200+ youth participants. The spring season included 278 U3-U5 Timbit Participants, 74 House Teams, and 8 Development/Select teams who participated in TOYSL.

Having spectators back in full force for Soccer Saturdays in the Shuswap was an awesome experience and seemed to bring joy back to soccer families from our community.
